Our regional area is the Northern Piedmont (NP) which includes 11 counties: Albemarle, Greene, Madison, Orange, Louisa, Nelson, Buckingham, Culpeper, Rappahannock, and Fauquier. A few stickered as Virginia Natives, **highlighted in orange** below, are outside our NP range, but are often found in the trade and native to elsewhere in Virginia.
